Daily Vocabulary Builder Journal

Please submit one word every day to make a minimum of 10 entries. If you exceed the minimum you will get extra credit.

Your final list should contain at least 10 words, their meanings, and an example of how to use them in a sentence. Please use the following guidelines to help build your list. You don't have to include all the elements in every entry. Just do as many as you can.

- 1. Copy the sentence from which you found the word you do not know.
- 2. Write the dictionary's definition and then define the entry in your own words and note the part of speech the entry plays in the sentence (it is a noun, verb, adjective?).
- 3. Find the root, prefix, or suffix.
- 4. Find words that use the same roots (if you cannot find the root just put NA for not applicable).
- 5. Finally, create your own sentence with the word.

RUBRIC

- A: The vocabulary journal contains 7 entries, and includes the words, their definitions, and an example of how to use them in a sentence.
- B: The vocabulary journal contains at least 6 entries, and includes the words, their definitions, and examples of how to use them in sentences.
- C: There are at least 5 entries, and there are elements missing from either the definitions or the sentence examples.
- D: There are less than 5 entries, and there are elements missing.
- F: There is no vocabulary journal.
