Have you looked at the architecture at Shepard Hall?

Have you looked at the painting, "The Graduate" in the Great Hall?

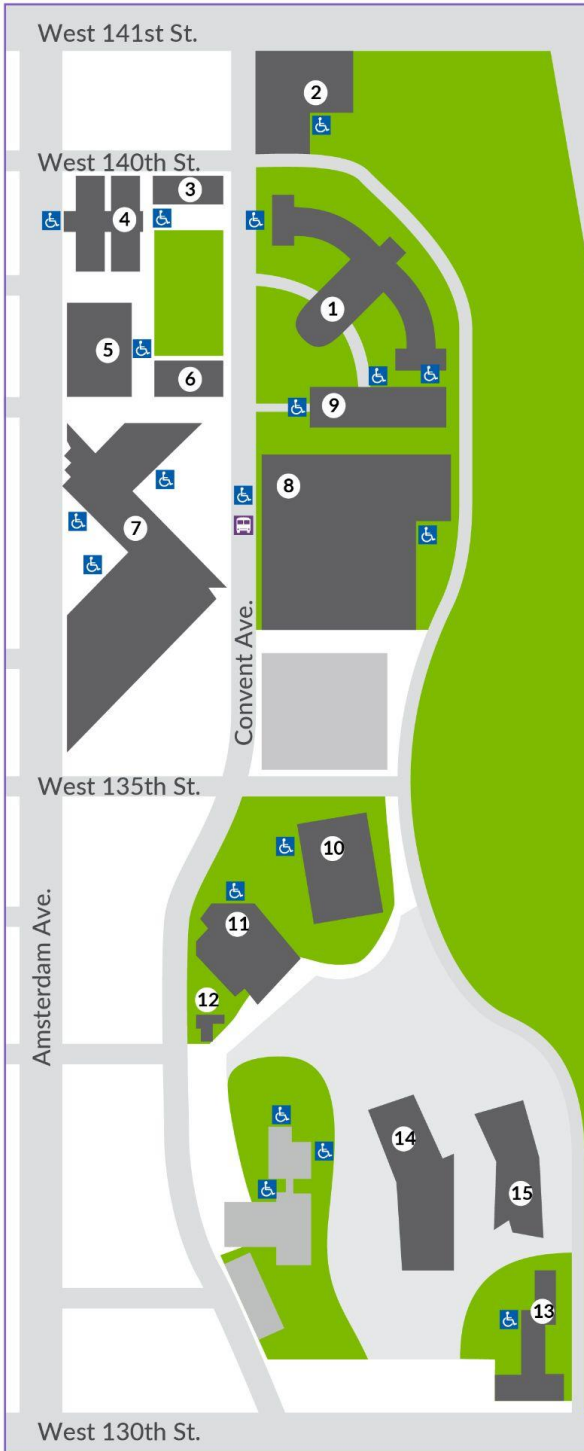
Have you wondered where the gym or the swimming pool are?
